From the desk of the Administrator

Resident's Rights:

Each resident has the right to immediate access by any representative of the Secretary, United States Department of Health and Human Services; any official properly acting for the state; the resident's individual physician; the state long-term care ombudsman and (as appropriate) other state agencies entitled to visit with residents under federal or state law, members of the resident's immediate family or other relatives, and any entity or individual providing health, social, legal or other services to the resident, subject to the resident's right to deny or withdraw consent for such visits. Each resident has the right to receive others subject to reasonable restrictions and the resident's right to deny or withdraw consent for such visits.

We are always looking for new entertainment for our residents. If you know of anyone that would be interested please give us a call and have them contact Amy Sparks, Activity Director.



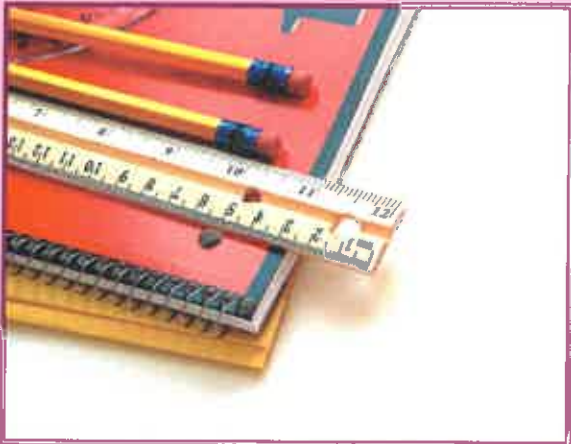
Help Wanted—Home Health
