From the desk of the Administrator

Resident's Rights:

Each Resident has the right to retain and use personal possessions, including some furnishings, and appropriate clothing, as space permits, unless to do so would infringe upon the rights or health and safety of other residents.

We encourage upon admission for every resident to bring items from home to decorate their room. This creates a more home like atmosphere. We ask that the path to exit the room and use the restroom are not blocked, there are no extension cords, nothing is placed within 18 inches from the ceiling, and no throw rugs are brought in. If you need assistance for hanging pictures on the wall let our staff know. If you need assistance with the setup of the room we can help.

Some families have a winter and a summer wardrobe and they rotate them with the seasons. Most families will store one wardrobe at home. This helps with storage and space. Please make sure that everything is labeled with the resident's name. Items can be labeled with a black marker or with labels the laundry and housekeeping are able to iron on.

In double rooms attempt to make sure that your items are not infringing upon the space of the opposite side of the room.

Cold and Flu season is upon us. If you have any signs and symptoms of the flu please refrain from visiting.

According to CDC.gov It has been recognized for many years that people 65 years and older are at greater risk of serious complications from the flu compared with young, healthy adults because human immune defenses become weaker with age. While flu seasons can vary in severity, during most seasons, people 65 years and older bear the greatest burden of severe flu disease. In recent years, for example, it's estimated that between 80 percent and 90 percent of seasonal flu-related deaths have occurred in people 65 years and older. Between 50 percent and 70 percent of seasonal flu-related hospitalizations have occurred among people in that same age group. Influenza is often quite serious for people 65 and older so please use good judgement if you are not feeling well before you visit.




