Each resident has the right to examine in a place readily accessible to residents, the results of the most recent survey of the facility conducted by a federal or state agency as well as any plan or correction in effect with respect to the facility. Each resident has the right to receive information from agencies acting as client advocates, and be afforded the opportunity to contact these agencies.

We provide a copy of our most current survey results for the residents to access by the front entrance of the Care Center. We are also conducting customer satisfaction surveys this month and will add this information to the state survey as soon as it has been completed.
