Resident's Rights:

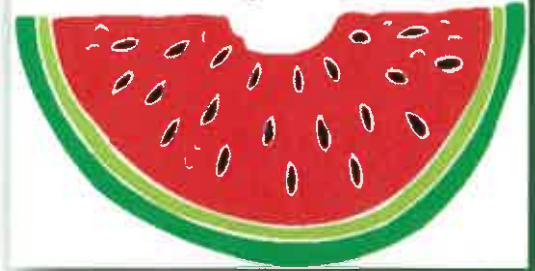
Planning and Implementing Care: The resident has the right to be informed of, and participate in, his or her treatment, including:
