Money and Property:

Each resident has the right to manage personal finances, or if he or she so chooses, to designate another party to manage them for him or her. We ask that all resident bring limited funds into the care center as we have many other residents, visitors, and staff. Funds are not usually needed in the care center as the care center pays for most outings and the beauticians will take payment via a billing method. Funds can also be deposited into a resident trust account, which we strongly encourage.

We can now do ACH for payment of your monthly bill! Contact Teresa Selken for information or see her in the business office. There are no extra fees for this service and minimal paperwork!




Thank you to the Benton Community Keystone
