Resident's Rights:

Each resident has the right to immediate access by any representative of the Secretary, United States Department of Health and Human Services; any official properly acting for the state; the resident's individual physician; the state long-term care ombudsman and (as appropriate) other state agencies entitled to visit with residents under federal or state law, members of the resident's immediate family or other relatives, and any entity or individual providing health, social, legal or other services to the resident, subject to the resident's right to deny or withdraw consent for such visits. Each resident has the right to receive others subject to reasonable restrictions and the resident's right to deny or withdraw consent for such visits.

Volunteers Needed:



Home Health Corner:



Keystone Home Health staff assist you in promoting and improving function in the home and avoid hospitalizations.

One example would be sending a Home Health Aide to assist with activities of daily living. This can include, assistance with bathing and dressing, oral care, and light housekeeping. The homemaker can also provide light housekeeping and may provide transportation to physician appointments and running errands.

Sometimes just adding this small amount support will reduce stress on caregivers and allow individuals to stay in their home longer.
